Guidelines and best practices for dialogue presentation

What is a Dialogue Session?

EVS33 dialogue presentations are poster-based sessions intended to be an efficient information vector for specialist and technical scientific papers. During dialogue sessions, presenters are able to review their work with attendees in an informal one-on-one or small group discussion at a scheduled time in a designated poster area.

Format:

- Every presenter will have a panel available allowing a poster of A0 format.
- Please include the EVS33 logo on the top left of the poster and follow the font size guidelines at the top of this page. The logo is available for download on the presenter section of the EVS33 website.
- Authors are encouraged to create engaging posters that attract attention and are easily read by visitors. Here are some tips to keep in mind:

- Do not reproduce large blocks of text from your paper. This is boring and unlikely to be read. Rather, include a few keywords or phrases that highlight the objectives and conclusions of your work.
- Text on the poster should be easily readable from a distance of one metre/three feet. Text should be at least 36 point; 24 point text may only be used for notes, references, etc. Text below 24 point shall NEVER be used.

Examples: **This is 60 point text.** **This is 48 point text.** **This is 36 point text.** This is 24 point text. This is 18 point text. This is 12 point text.

- Figures and graphics can greatly enhance the appearance of the poster. Please ensure that photos have an appropriate resolution; for line drawings, vector formats are to be preferred over bitmaps. Numerical data should be presented in graph format rather than table format.
